Age-standardised prevalence (%) of diabetes (20-79 years)

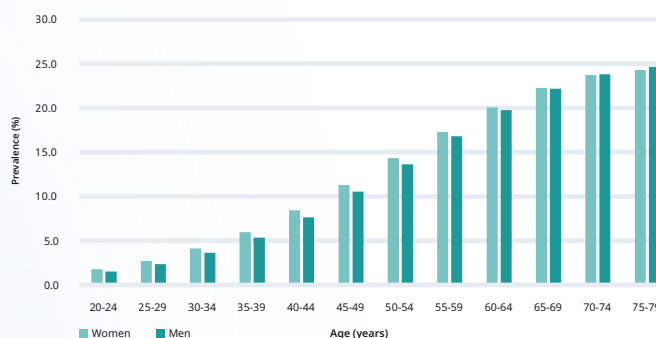

Highlights

- 1 in 10 adults have diabetes – 35 million.
- The number of adults with diabetes is expected to increase by 46% to 52 million by 2050.
- 1 in 3 adults living with diabetes (30.4%) are undiagnosed.
- Diabetes was responsible for 224,000 deaths in 2024.
- 797,000 people live with type 1 diabetes.
- Diabetes-related expenditure totals USD 81 billion in 2024.
- 1 in 6 live births are affected by hyperglycaemia in pregnancy.
